



EpiPen Rebate Information

Due to the price increase of EpiPen to over \$600, the manufacturer came out with a copay card that can be used up to \$300 toward the purchase of EpiPens.

In light of the news of EpiPen co-pay card increased amount, the Operating Engineers Local 49 Pharmacy Benefit Management Program, OptumRx, found out that any participant who already incurred expenses and did not know about the co-pay card, can submit a Rebate Request Form.

It can save participants and their families from **\$100 (before 8/25/16) to \$300 (after 8/25/16)**.

However, due to the timing of the release of this higher co-pay card, any EpiPen purchases from 8/25/16 to date are eligible for a reimbursement with the participant filling out a small bit of paperwork.

Step One – Activate an EpiPen card by selecting “Commercial Insurance” if covered under an IUOE Local 49 Health and Welfare plan.
