Dear Participant:

November 2018

The Trustees want to make sure that you are taking care of yourself and your dependents. Therefore, the Trustees announce the following enhancements to the Health and Welfare plan of benefits effective January 1, 2019:

Dental Benefit (not applicable to Retirees) –

The Board of Trustees believes it's important for you to visit your dentist at least 2 times per year. Therefore:

Routine dental exams and cleanings are covered 2 times per calendar year, instead of once every 6 months.

Prescription Drug Benefit –

The Board of Trustees believes it's important for you and your dependents to get your flu and other routine vaccinations. Therefore:

Flu shots and other routine adult vaccines administered at a network pharmacy participating in Optum's Vaccine Immunization/Injection Network are covered 100%, with no out-of-pocket expense to you.

Examples of routine vaccines include: Flu (Influenza); Hepatitis A & B (adult and pediatric); Human Papillomavirus (HPV); Measles; Mumps; Rubella; Meningococcal (Meningitis); Pneumococcal (Pneumonia); Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis); Varicella (chicken pox); Shingrix (Shingles).
